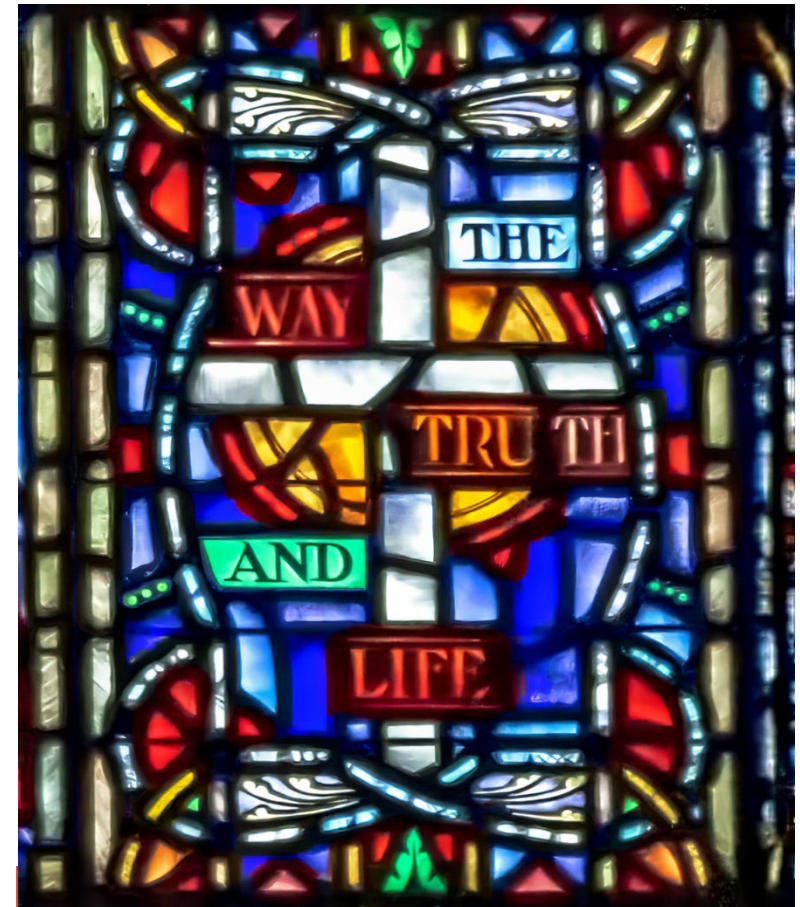
With Gratitude for the Resurrection: Mary B. Ruddle, a member since 1990, died on March 20.
